AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE INTEREST EARNED FROM THE AMERICAN SAMOA COMMUNITY COLLEGE LAND GRANT ENDOWMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMPUTER NETWORK SYSTEM AT THE AMERICAN SAMOA COMMUNITY COLLEGE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EARLY EFFECTIVE DATE.

Preamble:

This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage of the Legislature and approval by the Governor due to the urgent need to fund the purchase and implementation of a computer network system for the American Samoa Community College (ASCC), a Land Grant college, so that ASCC may provide critical services to: Land Grant operations, ASCC (a Land Grant college), the general public benefiting from the Land Grant college, students of the Land Grant college, faculty of the Land Grant college, and administration of the Land Grant, ASCC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA:

Section 1. Authorization of the use of funds.

Pursuant to 16.2011 A.S.C.A., the American Samoa Community College, under the administration of its President and the Board of Higher Education, is authorized to withdraw from the interest accumulated from the investments from the American Samoa Community College Land Grant Endowment Fund a total amount of five hundred thousand dollars and zero cents (\$500,000.00) for the sole purpose of purchasing and implementing a computer network system to be used in its daily activities including, but not limited to: (1) managing Land Grant college student records, (2) improving electronic, and computerized activities of the Land Grant college, (3) improving communication capabilities of the Land Grant college, (4) upgrading the overall computer information system of the Land Grant

college (ASCC), and (5) other residual benefits that may be inherent to the Land Grant college (ASCC) by the implementation of such a system.


Any funds remaining unexpended and unobligated after the purchase and installation/implementation of the computer network system shall be returned to the investment accounts for the American Samoa Community College Land Grant Endowment Fund.

Sec 2. Appropriation of funds.


Pursuant to 16.2011 A.S.C.A., there is appropriated the sum of five hundred thousand and zero cents (\$500,000.00) from the interest earned in the investment accounts of the American Samoa Community College Land Grant Endowment Funds for the sole purpose of purchasing and implementing a computer network system to be used in the day to day operation of the Land Grant programs and the Land Grant college (ASCC). The new computer network system will be used to include, but are not limited to: (1) managing Land Grant college student records, (2) improving electronic, and computerized activities of the Land Grant college, (3) improving communication capabilities of the Land Grant college, (4) upgrading the overall computer information system of the Land Grant college (ASCC), and (5) other residual benefits that may be inherent to the Land Grant college (ASCC) by the implementation of such a system.

Sec 3. Effective date.

This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage of the Legislature and approval by the Governor due to the emergency need to fund the purchase and implementation of a computer network system for the American Samoa Community College (ASCC) so that they may provide critical services to the general public, particular students, faculty, and administration of the ASCC.
