

Findings of the Court.

The statements alleged to have been spoken to a certain unknown lady and to diverse persons were not proven by testimony.

The evidence of the Governor showed that the conversation in the Governor's office during which these statements were alleged to have been made was a privileged one.

The plaintiff on the stand acknowledged giving liquor to natives.

No case has been proven by the plaintiff. Judgment is found therefore in favor of the defendant, the plaintiff to pay the costs.
